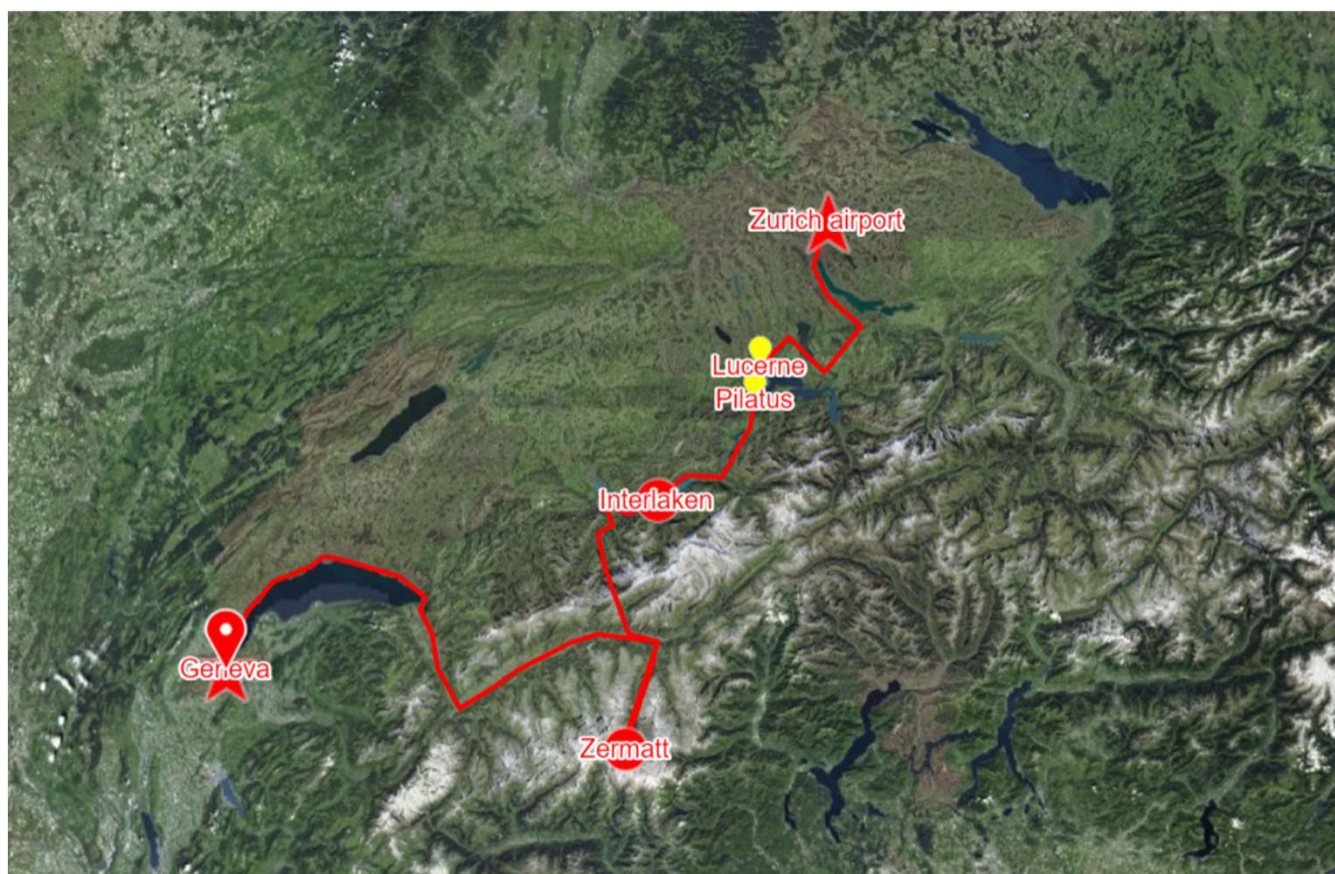




Post tour - From lake to peaks and vice versa

Start Geneva - Zermatt - Lucerne - Zurich

3 days / 2 nights



Day 1

Geneva - Lavaux – Zermatt

You will depart Geneva in direction of Zermatt including a tour of the Lavaux area, where you will get to taste Swiss wines and discover the Lemman Lake areas: Geneva, Lausanne and Montreux.

Lausanne, the second-largest city on Lake Geneva, combines a dynamic commercial town with the locality of a holiday resort. The capital of the canton of Vaud is also a lively university and convention town. Sports and culture are given a high profile in the Olympic capital.

From the lake to the mountains and vineyards, Montreux Riviera offers a postcard landscape. It's an authentic little piece of paradise that has attracted many artists, writers and travelers in search of beauty, tranquility and... inspiration.

Day 2

Excursion to the Gornergrat

Built in 1898, it is the first 100% electric rack train in Switzerland and the second in the world. The journey takes around 30 minutes and takes you to the top of Gornergrat at an altitude of 3,089 m.

From the platform, you can admire 29 peaks reaching an altitude of more than 4,000 meters (out of the 48 in Switzerland). And of course, you will enjoy a breathtaking view of the Matterhorn, which rises to 4,478 meters ... With a bit of luck, you may be able to spot marmots and chamois.

Take the time to marvel at the sight of these high peaks as above with Monte Rosa, and descend by train by the same route to Zermatt.

Overnight in Zermatt



Golden Round Trip to Mount Pilatus

Depart by train to Lucerne (via Visp and Bern).

The Golden round trip takes you to the most spectacular spots on the Pilatus and to the summit by boat, cogwheel railway, aerial cableway and Panorama Gondolas.

The starting point for the «Golden round trip» is in the heart of Lucerne. You will enjoy a boat trip on Lake Lucerne and a view of the surrounding mountains. The amazement continues. In Alpnachstad you will board the steepest cogwheel railway in the world to reach the summit. At 2,132 meters above sea level, the breathtaking panorama and view of the Alpine massif and its mountain range do their part to make your stay unforgettable.

You will then glide down to Kriens on the aerial cableway «Dragon Ride» and on the Panorama gondolas. From the valley station it is a five-minute walk to the stop for Bus no. 1 and a convenient ride back to Lucerne.

Embark on the train to Zurich where your journey ends.
