



Switzerland in a nutshell

Lake Geneva - Montreux - Gstaad - Lucerne - Zurich

3 days / 2 nights



Day 1

Geneva-Epesses-Chillon-Montreux-Villars

Start the day with a visit of Geneva: The symbol of the «world's smallest metropolis» is the "Jet d'eau" – a fountain with a 140-metre-high water jet at the periphery of Lake Geneva. The old town, the heart of Geneva with the shopping and business quarter, holds sway over the left-hand shore. It is dominated by St. Peter's Cathedral. Quays, lakeside promenades, countless parks, lively side streets in the old town and elegant shops invite guests to stroll.

Geneva is Switzerland's most international city, as it is where the European seat of the UNO is based. «Horloge Fleurie», the large flower clock in the "Jardin Anglais" (English Garden), is a world-renowned symbol of the Geneva watch industry.

Continue your day along the shores of Lemman Lake for a gourmet lunch in Vevey area, followed by a wine-tasting and a stroll through the Lavaux vineyards. Over 800 hectares, the terraced vineyards of the UNESCO region Lavaux form Switzerland's largest contiguous vineyard area with terrace after terrace offering magnificent views.

You will embark on a "Belle Epoque" boat for a cruise to Montreux Chillon: from the lake to the mountains and vineyards, Montreux Riviera offers a postcard landscape.

A must-do is the visit of Chillon Castle: Chillon Castle is located on a rock on the banks of Lake Geneva. The water castle is the most visited historic building in Switzerland.

Overnight in Villars



Day 2

Villars - Glacier 3000 - Les Diablerets – Gstaad

After an overnight in Villars, enjoy some mountain fun:

Les Diablerets, an important center for adventure sports, lies between Lake Geneva and Gstaad at an altitude of 1200 meters. Even in summer, the Glacier 3000 ski region in the heart of the Vaud Alps offers skiing and glacier enjoyment over an expansive area.

At Botta mountain station (3000 m), there is a flight of steps behind the house leading up to a viewing platform.

What you can also do, however, is walk in safety across the glacial plateau to the breathtaking "Quille du Diable" (sled-dog rides in winter, snow-bus in summer), or enjoy the Alpine Coaster, a new one-kilometer-long toboggan run.

Enjoy the visit of the chalet village of Gstaad itself and the smaller, rustic neighboring villages. The center of Gstaad has developed into a popular shopping area in recent years, and is the shortest shopping street in Switzerland.

Overnight in Gstaad



Gstaad - Lucerne –Zurich

Depart Gstaad:

Your journey will continue along some of the most beautiful Swiss lakes in direction of Bernese Overland.

You will depart to Lucerne to discover the old town and cross the oldest covered wooden bridge in Europe. Lucerne is a city of squares and churches, such as the 17th century Jesuit Church, which is the oldest sacred Baroque building in Switzerland. The Chapel Bridge was built in the 14th century and was originally part of the fortifications. The painted panels that were added in the 17th century represent scenes from the history of Switzerland and the city of Lucerne.



You will then uncover the secrets of Swiss chocolate. Chocolate experts will take you on a journey into the world of cocoa and impart knowledge about the quality and ingredients used to create chocolate. During a chocolate tasting you will enjoy 6 seasonal delicacies and can ask everything you always wanted to know about chocolate.
