Cheese, chocolate and wine in Gruyères and Lavaux

Departure in direction of the Gruyère region where you will visit an alpine cheese dairy. You will attend the production of the famous Gruyère AOP in the most traditional way. This cheese is made in Switzerland since 1115. 90 gallons of raw milk from cows that graze the lush grass and fragrant flora of alpine meadows situated between 800 and 1600 m above sea level (2400-4800 ft) are necessary to produce one 35-kg-wheel of Gruyère cheese. The cheese is then maturated during 6 to 24 month in a cellar to develop all its flavors.

After the visit, it's time to taste the production with an aperitif composed of cheese and local wine.

The day will continue with a bit of sweetness in the village of Broc, where you will visit the chocolate manufacture Cailler. In the unique museum, you will uncover the secrets of swiss chocolate and indulge your palate with an amazing variety of flavours during a chocolate tasting.

With a 10-min drive, you will reachthe charming village of Gruyères, the perfect place to taste the real swiss fondue.

In the afternoon, you will visit the wine region of "Lavaux" registered in the heritage of Unesco, and which is between Lausanne and Vevey. Always on secondary roads, you will take "La Corniche" balcony overlooking Lake Léman and on which are hung the beautiful villages of Riex, Epesses and Chexbres.

In one of these villages, a winegrower will present his estate and his production to you with supporting tastings.

Chillon - Leman Cruise - Lausanne

Starting the day with the visit of the most visited tourist attraction in Switzerland. Firstly, enjoy a Belle Epoque boat ride from Montreux to Chillon Castle: Chillon Castle is located on a rock on the banks of Lake Geneva. The water castle is the most visited historic building in Switzerland. For nearly four centuries Chillon was the residence and profitable toll station of the Counts of Savoy.

Then heading to Lausanne for a tour of the city including the Olympic Museum: to experience the Olympics at close quarters and feel the Olympic spirit the way the athletes felt it, to study the history of the Games from antiquity to today – thanks to the latest computer technology and audiovisual media, all of this can be accomplished in the Olympic Museum in Lausanne. Full day excursion watchmaking in Vallée de Joux and Geneva

Today's visit takes you to the nest of watchmaking. The Vallée de Joux with its long watchmaking tradition is a world of its own in rugged and unspoilt countryside nestling between Jura Mountain Ranges.

In the museum, immerse yourself in the world of fine timekeepers and learn about the history of the mastery of time since the 15th century.

Lunch will take place in the dazzling setting of the Hotel des Horlogers opened by Audemars Piguet in 2022.

Back in Geneva, stroll the old town to discover how the town became the world capital city of luxury watchmaking and all the brands who contributed to this success.
