Zurich Food Tour

Meeting point: Zurich airport at 10:00 hrs for a tour of the city, followed by a visit of Lucerne and Interlaken.

Zurich is Switzerland's center of economic life and education. Located in the heart of Europe, the city offers all the modern amenities of a cosmopolitan metropolis, without sacrificing its natural side. Zurich has for years ranked among the world's top cities in terms of quality of life. It is a boutique city that offers everything that implies, albeit in small and exquisite format.

Walking tour through the Old Town of Zurich, which will introduce you to the most famous Swiss specialities. The guide will focus on Zurich specialities as well as the culinary history behind them. Learn on this 3h tour about traditional Swiss food, our famous cheese and meat dishes, "Spanisch-Brötli-Bahn" ("Spanish small buns train"), the traditional "Tirggel" cookie, the story of Sprüngli, what the locals would have eaten hundreds of years ago as well as which Zurich food start-ups are currently changing the world. The guide will tell you stories and show you places that even most locals have never heard about, the best part being: You will get to try 15+ delicious foods and beverages.

Zurich - Lucerne - Interlaken

Lucerne, the gateway to central Switzerland, on Lake Lucerne, is embedded within an impressive mountainous panorama. Thanks to its attractions, its attractive shopping offer, the beautiful lakeside setting and the nearby excursion mountains of the Rigi, Pilatus and Stanserhorn, the town is a destination for many travel groups and individuals on their journey through central Switzerland.

Full day Ballenberg – Rothorn

Today enjoy a full day excursion in central Switzerland. At the Open-Air Museum Ballenberg you can explore over 100 historic buildings from all over Switzerland. What stories do these buildings tell? Try out old crafts and get up close and personal with farm animals.

Then full steam ahead to the Rothorn Kulm

Climb the mountain without breaking a sweat: chugging along alpine meadows and through lush forests on the rack railway built in 1892, you approach a breathtaking panorama under your own steam. On a clear day, the Rothorn offers you a magnificent view of no fewer than 693 peaks.

Enjoy a cruise on Brienzer lake: There has been a regular boat service on Lake Brienz since 1839! The turquoise Lake Brienz and neighboring Lake Thun are set amid the spectacular mountain scenery of the Bernese Oberland. Overnight in Interlaken

Full day excursion Jungfraujoch

Today's visit puts a jewel in the crown of any visit to Switzerland: the Top of Europe

The tunnel leading up from the station Eigergletscher is seven kilometers in length and was built between 1896 and 1912. One stop within the tunnel offers spectacular views onto the glacier world outside through windows in the Eiger North Face. On the summit, visitors are greeted by a high-Alpine wonder world made of ice, snow and rocks. All of this can be marveled at from the viewing platforms "Sphinx" and "Plateau" on the Aletsch glacier or from the "Ice Palace".

Interlaken - Bern – Geneva

Depart Interlaken towards Geneva, enjoying a city tour of Bern on the way. Not many cities have managed to retain their historic features quite as successfully as Bern, the capital of Switzerland. The old town of Bern is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and thanks to its 6 kilometres of arcades - the locals refer to them as 'Lauben' - boasts on of the longest weather-sheltered shopping promenades in Europe.
