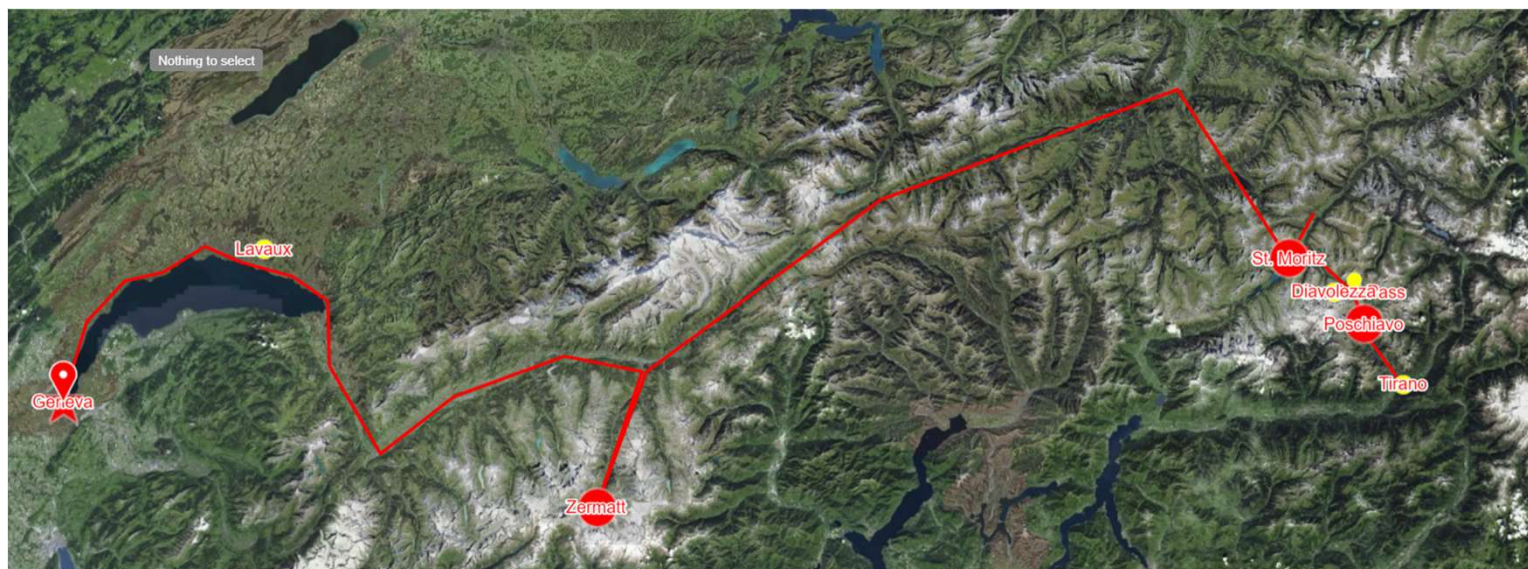




Panoramic train tour Milano (Italy) - St.Moritz - Zermatt - Lake Geneva

5 days / 4 nights



Day 1

Milano (Italy) - Tirano – Poschiavo

Private transfer from Milano to Tirano (Italy)

Meeting point 11:00 Malpensa airport, it takes almost 3 hours by road to Tirano.

You will there board the Bernina Express, a spectacular railway line, for a fairly short first stage of 41 minutes.

From the palm trees of Italy to the shimmering glaciers, the Bernina Express, which makes the highest altitude route through the Alps, connects North and South, thus creating a kind of bridge between the linguistic regions and cultures.

At Brusio you will have your first helicoidal loop, which will be followed by several others over the charming town of Poschiavo in the form of a tunnel, before arriving at the Bernina Pass.

Day 2

Poschiavo - Bernina Pass - Diavolezza - St.Moritz

From Poschiavo, the train takes you to the Bernina Pass through several spiral tunnels, which allow you to see Poschiavo and its lake from different altitudes.

At 2253 meters above sea level, the Ospizio Bernina awaits you at the highest point of the route listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. That says a lot. You will enjoy a spectacular immersion in the Alpine panorama.

From the pass, it will descend a few kilometers to the start of the Diavolezza cable car.

From the summit, at 2,973m, comfortably installed on a terrace for lunch, an impressive panorama will unfold before your eyes from Piz Palü to Piz Bernina, via Bellavista.

Then return to the station by cable car to take the train to Pontresina and then to St Moritz.



St.Moritz-Zermatt

You will board the Glacier Express, a legendary train connecting St.Moritz to Zermatt covering a distance of nearly 300 km. The train is not an express in the sense that it is not a high-speed train, but rather in the sense that it allows one trip to be made at one time, without changing at intermediate stations.

The route crosses 291 bridges, 91 tunnels and allows you to enjoy spectacular landscapes thanks to its floor-to-ceiling windows.

In option: Travel in Excellence class

A rail journey through the Swiss Alps has never been so luxurious. With guaranteed window seats, an exclusive bar, on-board entertainment, a concierge service and personal travel guides, the Glacier Express Excellence Class is setting new standards. The journey between St. Moritz and Zermatt is a feast for the senses: while the spectacular landscape passes by outside, guests are served champagne and amuse-bouches – followed by an exquisite five-course meal with accompanying wine.

Excursion to the Gornergrat

Built in 1898, it is the first 100% electric rack train in Switzerland and the second in the world. The journey takes around 30 minutes and takes you to the top of Gorner- grat at an altitude of 3,089 m.

From the platform, you can admire 29 peaks reaching an altitude of more than 4,000 meters (out of the 48 in Switzerland). And of course, you will enjoy a breathtaking view of the Matterhorn, which rises to 4,478 meters ... With a bit of luck, you may be able to spot marmots and chamois.

Take the time to marvel at the sight of these high peaks as above with Monte Rosa, and descend by train by the same route to Zermatt.

Overnight in Zermatt



Zermatt - Lavaux – Geneva

You will depart towards Geneva including a tour of the Lavaux area, where you will get to taste Swiss wines and discover the Leman Lake areas: Montreux, Lausanne and Geneva

From the lake to the mountains and vineyards, Montreux Riviera offers a postcard landscape. It's an authentic little piece of paradise that has attracted many artists, writers and travelers in search of beauty, tranquility and... inspiration.

Lausanne, the second-largest city on Lake Geneva, and capital of the canton of Vaud is a lively university and convention town, home to International Olympic Committee.

End with a guided tour of Geneva to discover its unique nature. World famous as the city of peace, host of hundreds of UN agencies and NGO's, Geneva is also the smallest of the world metropolis' where everything is within walking distance. Did you know that Geneva saw the birth of the very first humanitarian organization in 1863 or that multilateralism started here over 100 years ago ? Geneva also boasts one of the highest quality of life being the 2nd greenest cities in Europe an a leader regarding sustainable development and energy savings.
