




Switzerland in a nutshell

Zurich - Lucerne - Gstaad - Montreux - Geneva

3 days / 2 nights



Day 1

Zurich – Lucerne – Bernese Overland

You will depart to Lucerne to discover the old town and cross the oldest covered wooden bridge in Europe. Lucerne is a city of squares and churches, such as the 17th century Jesuit Church, which is the oldest sacred Baroque building in Switzerland. The Chapel Bridge was built in the 14th century and was originally part of the fortifications. The painted panels that were added in the 17th century represent scenes from the history of Switzerland and the city of Lucerne.



You will then uncover the secrets of Swiss chocolate. Chocolate experts will take you on a journey into the world of cocoa and impart knowledge about the quality and ingredients used to create chocolate. During a chocolate tasting you will enjoy 6 seasonal delicacies and can ask everything you always wanted to know about chocolate.

Your journey will continue along some of the most beautiful Swiss lakes in direction of Bernese Overland.



Day 2

Gstaad - Glacier 3000 - Les Diablerets – Villars

Enjoy the visit of the chalet village of Gstaad itself and the smaller, rustic neighboring villages. The center of Gstaad has developed into a popular shopping area in recent years, and is the shortest shopping street in Switzerland.



Then enjoy some mountain fun:

Les Diablerets, an important center for adventure sports, lies between Lake Geneva and Gstaad at an altitude of 1200 meters. Even in summer, the Glacier 3000 ski region in the heart of the Vaud Alps offers skiing and glacier enjoyment over an expansive area.

Within just 15 minutes, you will get whisked from the valley floor to 3k altitudes – no switching required. At the top, you will surely notice the summit station designed by Swiss architect Mario Botta. The various look-out points at Glacier 3000 offer panoramic views of two dozen snow-capped peaks above 4000 meters of altitude: Eiger, Mönch, Jungfrau, the Matterhorn, Grand Combin, and even Mont Blanc in the far distance.

Just outside the cable car station is the Peak Walk by Tissot, the world's first suspension footbridge spanning two summits.



Overnight in Villars

Villars – Montreux – Lavaux – Geneva

From Villars, continue your journey to the shores of Lemman Lake for a cruise and visit of Chillon castle, a gourmet lunch in Vevey area, followed by a wine-tasting and a stroll through the Lavaux vineyards.

You will embark on a "Belle Epoque" boat for a cruise to Montreux Chillon: from the lake to the mountains and vineyards, Montreux Riviera offers a postcard landscape.

A must-do is the visit of Chillon Castle: Chillon Castle is located on a rock on the banks of Lake Geneva. The water castle is the most visited historic building in Switzerland.



Continue your day along the shores of Lemman Lake for a gourmet lunch in Vevey area, followed by a wine-tasting and a stroll through the Lavaux vineyards. With 800 hectares, the terraced vineyards of the UNESCO region Lavaux form Switzerland's largest contiguous vineyard area with terrace after terrace offering magnificent views.

End the day with a visit of Geneva: The symbol of the «world's smallest metropolis» is the "Jet d'eau" - a fountain with a 140-metre-high water jet at the periphery of Lake Geneva. The old town, the heart of Geneva with the shopping and business quarter, holds sway over the left-hand shore. It is dominated by St. Peter's Cathedral. Quays, lakeside promenades, countless parks, lively side streets in the old town and elegant shops invite guests to stroll. Geneva is Switzerland's most international city, as it is where the European seat of the UNO is based. «Horloge Fleurie», the large flower clock in the "Jardin Anglais" (English Garden), is a world-renowned symbol of the Geneva watch industry.
