June 18 

Zurich-Basel

Morning, departure by private van from Zurich airport to Basel. Basel, the city of culture for connoisseurs has the highest concentration of museums in the country. The old Town has some charm, modern architecture is all around, you really will enjoy it! Today, it's the last day of ART BASEL.

Upon your arrival, you will be dropped at the entrance. The whole afternoon is necessary to appreciate this N° 1 world contemporary art exhibition.

BASEL - VEVEY

Morning will be at the Beyeler Fondation: An uplifting experience right from the start. The aesthetically pleasing construction by the Italian architect Renzo Piano surrounded by an idyllic park with trees and sculptures on the green carpet of grass exude a contagious, peaceful mood. But even inside the Fondation Beyeler building you meet with a relaxed atmosphere. The 250 masterpieces of 20th century art of the Hildy and Ernst Beyeler collection enjoy plenty of space in bright rooms with artists such as Monet, Cézanne, Van Gogh, Warhol, Lichtenstein, Bacon, Hodler, without forget Picasso.

At time of your visit, you will admire at ground floor, reserved for high-profile temporary exhibitions, BASQUIAT.

In the afternoon, drive to the Lemman Lake on the Riviera side.

From your hotel, you will have a wonderful view of Vevey, Montreux, the lake with the Alps in the background. Before dinner, visit of a local winemaker for a degustation.

June 20 



Vevey – Montreux – Rochers de Naye – Chillon Castle – Lausanne – Geneva

Morning, departure to the city of Montreux.

Montreux enjoys a privileged location between the lake and the mountains, creating a mild and pleasant micro climate throughout the year - an ideal environment for beautiful flowers and tropical plants. That's partly why we love strolling along its flower-lined quays, gazing out at Lake Geneva. Culture-wise, jazz lovers have flocked to Montreux since 1967, and over the decades, the Montreux Jazz Festival has become an unmissable event on the shores of Lake Geneva. But we can't resist the charm of the Belle Époque architecture that hides many intriguing stories.

At the railway station, you will take a cogwheel train to reach the Rochers de Naye Peak. It offers a unique panoramic view of the Swiss and French Alps: from the Eiger to Mont-Blanc.

Back at Montreux, your private van will take you to the famous Chillon Castle.

The rocky island on which the castle sits, occupied since the Bronze Age, constituted both a form of natural protection and a strategic positioning to control passage from the North to the South of Europe. As an exceptional heritage monument, Chillon Castle has around 300 items on display throughout, including furniture, weapons, and armor.

Then a historical Paddle Steamer will take you from the pier along the Lavaux vineyards, a Unesco Heritage site, to Lausanne. By train, you will go back to Geneva.

Your journey ends upon arrival in Geneva
